Event Location and Schedule

- Location: Around Again store at 22 Gilbert Road in Sequim on the corner of Gilbert Road and Hgwy 101 by Taylor Cutoff Road. The event will be held in the parking lot.
- Date: Sunday July 15, 2018.
- Open to the public: 10am 4pm.
- Open to the vendors and participants: 8:30am 5pm.

Participation Criteria

- Vendors will be vetted to ensure that their offerings fit the Refaire mission "Recycle, Reuse, Repurpose".
- Resellers of new products, multi-tier marketing businesses and commercial businesses may not participate.
- No new items can be sold. Sale items other than food must be made of at least 70 percent repurposed, reused or recycled materials. Repurposed items are okay if they are vintage and not new items made to look vintage.

Application Time Line

- Applications are available at Around Again and online at AroundAgainStore.org.
- Deadline for submitting applications: July 1, 2018
- You will be contacted: 1 week after your application is received.
- Please let us know at least a week in advance if you need to cancel, thank you!

Art and Craft Vendors

- Vendors understand that Around Again provides only spaces and electric power.
- Vendors are responsible for securing booths, power cords, signs etc. so that they are not a safety hazard (i.e., no trip hazards, must be wind proof and electrical shock proof, etc.).
- Vendor set up & take down times: The grounds will open for vendors to set up at 8:30am. Take down will begin at 4pm and should be completed by 5pm.
- Vendor set up, take down & parking: Vendors will drive on to the grounds to set up and take down and park vehicles in a lot across Gilbert Street during the event.

Food Vendors

- Vendors understand that Around Again provides only spaces and electric power.
- Prepackaged/cottage-food industry vendors: Vendors must provide required food vendor documents immediately upon registration. No food vendor documents, no participation.
- Food vendors in self-contained vehicles and booths must provide Temporary Food Facility (TFF) documents immediately upon registration. No (TFF) documents, no participation.
